Be it Remembered, That on the 15th day of May in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Four, Guy Crosby late of Scotland, in the Kingdom of Great Britain &c, at present of Beaver County, in the Territory aforesaid, appeared in the **Third Judicial District Court** of the United States, in and for Utah Territory, and applied to the said Court to be admitted to become a **Citizen of the United States of America**, pursuant to the directions and requirements of the several Acts of Congress in relation thereto. And the said Guy Crosby having thereupon produced to the Court such evidence, made such declaration and renunciation, and taken such oath as are by the said Acts required; thereupon it was ordered by the said Court that the said Guy Crosby be admitted, and he was accordingly admitted by the said Court to be a **Citizen of the United States of America**.
